Message from Mayor Jun-ichiro Hoshino

Regarding the vaccine allocation for novel corona virus, we will inform you as soon as specific vaccine allocation to the city is decided.

Using the subsidy of the central government, we have prepared about 15 billion yen as the expenses to prevent COVID-19. For the new fiscal year budget of 2021, we will prepare necessary expenses to support elderly people's facilities and medical institutions in addition to the vaccination.

For the address to support child raising, we aim to complete rebuilding Kohokudai Nursery School in 2021 as a complex facility with child raising support facility.

In addition, to support safe and secure life, we will build the new clean center, a fire station in Nakazato area, Teganuma - Kujike Route, elevators at Abiko Station and flood-control infrastructure in such area as Shibasaki, Fusa and Wakamatsu.

We must promote various projects steadily though our revenues reduced due to the influence of COVID-19.

We would like to ask you to cooperate with us in order to build the basis for the town where everybody can live safely and securely and wants to settle down.

New Town Building Plan for Bright Future

In order to develop Abiko City as an independent town for future, we will promote measures to revitalize the town, especially for young generation to settle in Abiko.

Five Main Projects in 2021

Project 1

We respect nature unique to Abiko such as Lake Teganuma and build environmentally-friendly town.

Project 2

We build a rich and lively town by utilizing our cultural and natural resources.

Project 3

We build a town where everybody can live safely.

Project 4

We build a town in which young generation chooses to live.

Project 5

We build a town where everybody can live a healthy and independent life without worries throughout one's life.

Budgets for Five Main Projects in the 2021 FY are as follows:

Project 1

- Building the new Clean Center: Budget six billion yen
This center is intended to operate in 2023.
- Promotion of Energy Saving: Budget 82 million yen

Project 2

- Preservation and use of cultural treasures: Budget 10 million yen
- Agricultural support: Budget 3.57million yen
- Creating environment for companies to invest and operate easily in Abiko: Budget 3 million yen
- Improvements to revitalize Lake Teganuma and its surrounding: Budget 3.75 million yen
- Maintenance of Life-long Learning Center "Abisuta" : Budget 152 million yen

Project 3

- Measures to prevent disasters and make first action: Budget 7 million yen
- Measures to prevent damage by a flood: Budget 658 million yen

Project 4

- Dispatching the attractions of Abiko: Budget 4.7 million yen
- Measures for settlement of young generation and falling birthrate: Budget 41 million yen
- Improvements of pre-school facilities: Budget 310 million yen
- Improvement of convenience in transportation: Budget 200 million yen

Project 5

- Support for Influenza and pneumococcal vaccination: :Budget 102 million yen
- Support to elderly people : Budget 12 million yen
