Call Fire Station at 7184-0119. They will advise you of an appropriate holiday/night-time emergency hospital or pediatrician. Before going there, talk with the hospital on the phone about your sickness or injury. In urgent cases, call 119 for an ambulance.

2. Child's Sudden Illness at Night: telephone consultation with a nurse

Call #8000 or 043-242-9939 Hours: 19:00 – 6:00 next day A nurse will advise you about the care to be taken for your infant/child.

3. Sudden Illness at Night and Holidays: telephone consultation with a nurse

Call #7009 or 03-6735-8305 Hours: weekdays and Saturdays 18:00 – 23:00
Sundays, Holidays and year-end/New Year holidays: 9:00 – 23:00

4. Illness or Toothaches on Holidays: contact Holiday Clinic at 7187-7020

(1) Dentist: 9:00-11:30 (2) Internal Medicine & Pediatrician: 9:00 – 11:30, 13:00 – 16:30
