## Access to Abiko

### By Train

#### a) From Narita Airport

Take the JR Airport Line to JR Narita Station, or take the Keisei Line to Keisei Narita Station plus a 3-minute walk to JR Narita Station; then take the JR Narita Line ( nicknamed "Water-Sky Line" ) to Abiko; about 80 minutes in total.

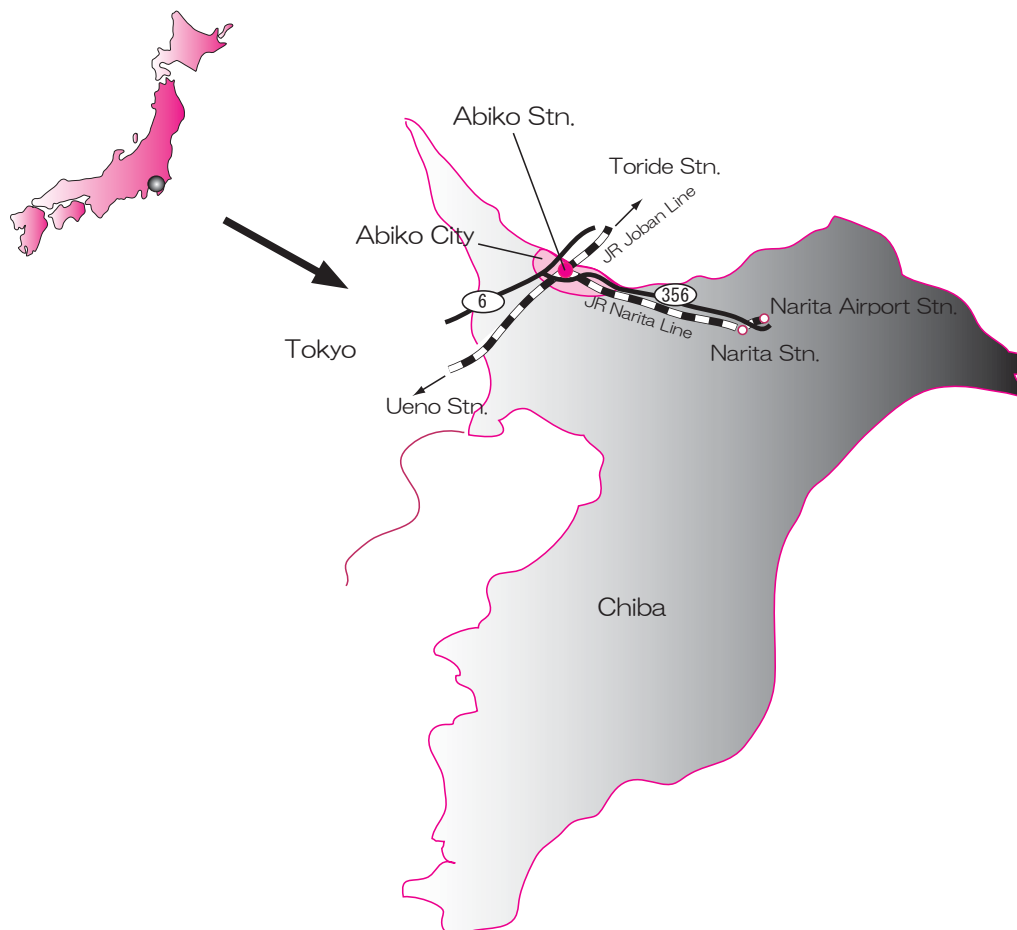
#### b) From Tokyo

Take the JR Yamanote Line or the JR Keihin Tohoku Line and change at Ueno or Nippori Station to the JR Joban Line; about 45 minutes to Abiko in total.

### By Car

You can reach Abiko by car from Narita Airport through motorways in about 1 hour. Major motorways intersecting in Abiko are National Routes 6 and 356. Prefectural motorway Funabashi-Abiko connects Toride and Funabashi through Abiko.



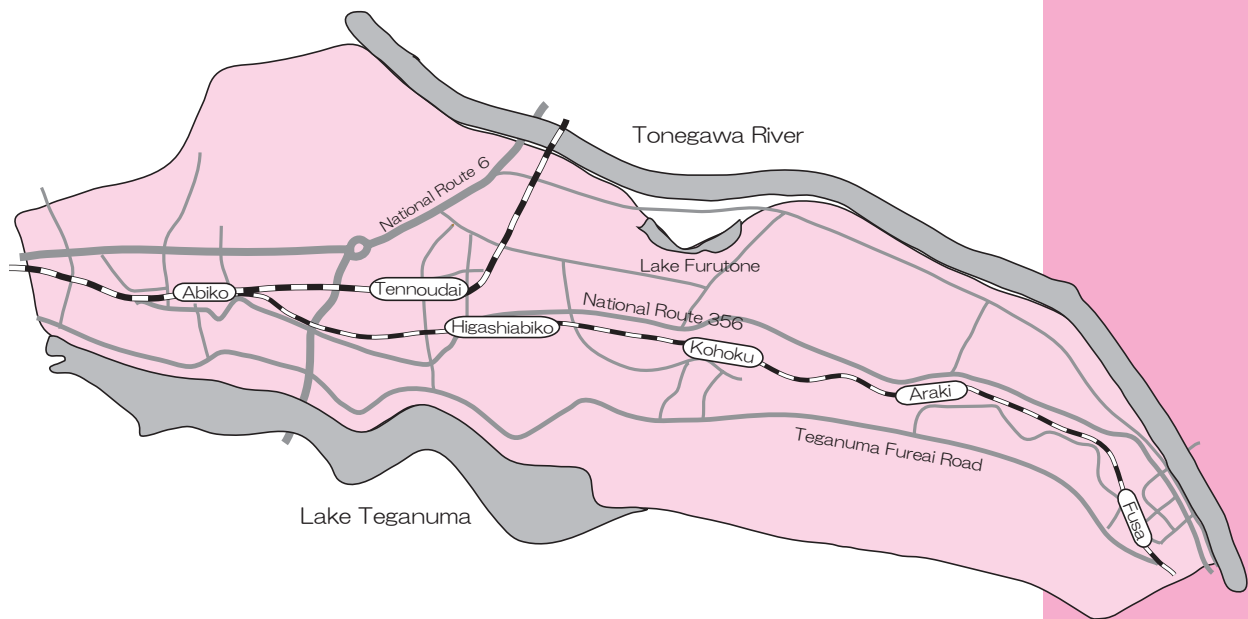

## Train Services

The JR Narita Line and the JR Joban Line run through Abiko.

**How to Buy a Ticket** You can buy tickets from ticket machines. Fare for a child, 6-12 years old, is half the adult fare. Up to two accompanied children under 6 years old are free. A book of tickets, commuter passes and prepaid cards are also available. For booking and/or buying tickets of Shinkansen or other special limited express trains, ask at the Green Window of Abiko Station. These special tickets are also obtainable through the internet or travel agencies.

## Bus Services

Two different buses serve the city : Bando Bus and Civic Bus.

### Bando Bus (commercial)

Get in at the middle, and leave from the front door. When you get on the bus, take a slip with a bus-stop number out of the box at the entrance. Right before getting off the bus, find the number on your slip and corresponding fare on the "fare display panel" beside the driver. Then drop the exact amount of coins into the fare box together with the slip. Fare for a child at 6-12 years old is half the adult fare and one child under 6 years old accompanied by adult is free. You can buy a book of tickets from the bus driver when the bus stands still. When you want to get off the bus, press any one of the purple-colored buttons to notify the driver.

### Civic Bus (city-run)

JR Kohoku Station (North exit) – Araki area – City Gymnasium – Elderly Welfare Center *Tsutsujiso*, and vice versa.

**Day of Service** Tuesday to Saturday (except holidays and Yearend/New Year holidays).

Fare : 100 yen (all routes). Children under 6 years are free.
