Abiko City will celebrate the 55th anniversary of its municipal government on July 1st, 2025. We will hold celebrations with the citizens so that they can have greater pride in and stronger affection for Abiko.

We will hold "Abiko Kotobuki Rakugo Story-telling Theater" on January 19th and "Abiko Hometown Comedy Live" on February 22nd, where the hometown ambassador, Mr. Nobuyuki Hanawa, will perform a comedy, and release a map of filming locations. We are also planning a commemorative event "Sky Lantern Event", which was presented by students from Chuo Gakuin University and won the gold award in the policy proposal presentation.

Municipal and prefectural tax filing period is from January 23 (Thu) to March 17 (Mon), and income tax filing period is from February 17 (Mon) to March 17 (Mon). During the filing period, Kashiwa Tax Office will open a tax return preparation venue and offer free consultations with tax accountants, and the city will open tax filing venues. In fiscal 2025, when the city will mark each of these milestones, we will work on commemorative projects such as having "Abiko Peace Day," to hold peace-related events and producing "Peace Songs".

◆ Cranes folded by Sadako

A precious origami crane folded by Sadako Sasaki during her lifetime is on permanent display at Abista. She is the model for the "Children of the Atomic Bomb" statue in Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park. The paper crane was donated by Sadako's brother, Masahiro and her nephew, Yuji, who sympathized with the city's peace project. Sadako, who suffered from leukemia after the atomic bombing, folded cranes using medicine and caramel wrappers, hoping to "live".



Advance Care Planning to make a choice you won't regret

“Advance Care Planning” is an attempt to think in advance about the terminal medical and nursing care you'd like, and talk about it repeatedly with your family and medical and nursing care teams, and share it. Have you ever thought about your medical care you would like to receive if you became unrecovred with a sudden illness or accident. Even if you think about it, you might rarely talk to your family or friends. The purpose of Advance Care Planning is not the end of your life, but the preparation to live your final moments in the best way as you want. It is a good chance to talk to your loved ones while you are still well.

Advance Care Planning: talking about and sharing how you'd like to spend your last stage of life such as terminal medical care and treatment and the place where you want to spend your final stage of life.

End-of-life Planning: making arrangements for after death: funeral and grave preparation, will and inheritance procedures

Three advantages of Advance Care Planning:

1. Your wishes will be reflected in the terminal medical care and treatment.
2. Trusted people will convey your wishes to your healthcare staff.
3. You don't have to let your beloved ones make a tough decision.

Three cycles

1. Think about terminal medical care and treatment you'd like to receive.
2. Share your wishes with your family or friends and discuss them with your doctor and care manager.
3. Write down what you discussed and agreed. That will serve as a message even if you become unable to express your wishes due to serious illness or accident.
